





Stewards of 8 EDEN HILL ROAD

When traveling from a Midwestern city to Connecticut for graduate school decades ago, I was struck by the many differences in terrain. I grew up with sidewalks, rectangular blocks, and flat land with few wooded areas. Although often getting lost in Fairfield County's winding back roads, I was drawn to the forests, unique stone walls, and the much older historic structures.

I moved to Newtown in the 1980s with my husband Jean Mathurin and then toddling son Seth. Several years later, we were happily joined by our second son Jordan. Knowing we liked old homes, the realtor recommended the primitive center-chimney colonial at 8 Eden Hill Road. Never setting foot in a 300+-year-old building, this house went well beyond "old." The house stood empty at the time, the pilot and stewardess owners realizing such a dwelling was not conducive to their lifestyle.

I sat alone in the furniture-less house, getting a feel for its unfamiliar low ceilings, large-beamed ceilings, narrow staircase, and wide chestnut floors. How different from my childhood 1950s ranch-style home. The surroundings provided comfort, and Jean loved the stone walkways and patio, wide-open backyard, and wooded area beyond. This was well before surrounding developments arrived. I also checked the town's list of hauntings, and we've had no sightings!

As a writer, I describe the house in literary terms: Its walls hold memories of residents since circal690 – the date on our certificate from the Newtown Historical Society. Past town historian Dan Cruson believed this to be one of the oldest, if not the oldest, Newtown homes. The General Assembly granted Captain Ebenezer Johnson 300 acres, where he was required

to build a house at least 18 feet square. Since he lived in the Borough, the first tenants were likely farmers.

In the 19th century, the Hattertown Green included several hats, buttons, and combs industries and shops, along with a general store, blacksmith, wagon shop, grist mill, and the stench of manufacturing chemicals. The term "mad as a hatter" actually came from the industry's mercury poisoning. When digging out a swampy area by our property a few years ago, we found many scraps from leather shoes. This isn't surprising since shoemakers were much in demand, with many area towns known for the trade. It's easy to imagine the cobblers working by our large hearth. Today, our rooms

display Native American photographs and collectibles and early American ephemera, artwork, and furniture. These are befriended by many chiming period clocks that Jean winds up daily. The house's tenants have come from many backgrounds. They included Edith Halpert, who immigrated with her mother in 1906 to escape the Russian Jewish persecution. She became the first woman to own a commercial NYC art gallery. In the summertime, she welcomed friends such as artist Georgia O'Keeffe, photographer Alfred Stieglitz, and client Abby Aldrich Rockefeller. Her attic was filled with collectible samovars. In contrast, another resident supposedly parked his Harley Davidson in the hearth.

I love how our house continually settles around the central chimney, making some rooms uneven like a carnival house of mirrors. To me, it keeps breathing in and out with a life of its own. We even have names for the closet and bathroom doors that open by themselves from air pressure or stepping on certain floor planks. Such an abode is best for anyone enjoying such idiosyncrasies. However, Johnson's house was built incredibly well, standing strong against the New England weather since 1690. It will surely

continue to outlast many others. I'm proud to be one of its stewards and hold it for future generations.

Buttermilk



I quickly realized that I am gifted, gentle, and eager to love others that need some comfort and support. This started my journey to become a therapy dog through The Exceptional Sidekick Service Dogs and Therapy Dogs (exceptionalsidekick.org). Since my certification, I've had visits to middle schools, elementary schools, high schools, bookstores, charity races, and nursing homes. I have two regular therapy visits weekly. I visit

patients in the memory care unit at our local nursing home every Tuesday, and I go to Bethel Public Schools every Friday to visit with my many friends. Did you know that my visits can help lower blood pressure and help non-verbal people connect to the world? And that is just skimming the surface!

I have a few other AKC titles to add to my therapy certification. I have both my novice and intermediate trick dog titles (TKN, TKI). Additionally, I have my Canine Good Citizen (CGC), Community Canine Advanced (CGCA), and Canine Good Citizen Urban (CGCU) titles. Training and learning are lifelong goals for me, and I hope to add more titles to my name!

My brother Gunnie is an AKC Grand Champion (GCH)! He found his way to our home for some additional training and obedience, while our breeder raises a new litter of Doberman puppies. His stay was supposed to be temporary, but he fell in love with my person's daughter Reese. When the opportunity to have Gunnie rehomed to stay permanently presented itself, we could not say no! We are so happy he will be with us forever! Gunnie is also taking classes and learning every day. He will soon be adding his CGC title to his GCH title. He is my best friend, and I am so glad we can be together.

I have a special surprise to share. We are getting one more puppy, coming Valentine's weekend. She is a black Doberman pinscher and will be 10 weeks old. Her AKC registered name is Mystikos It's Not The Destination, but we will call her "Journey." My brother Gunnie and I cannot wait to see the future she will have in our home. I am sure she'll make big goals for herself.

If you ever see me or my dog brother and sister going for runs down Equestrian Ridge or Poverty Hollow with my person, please stop and say hello to us!
